A journalistic photographer — played by the brilliant and iconic Jimmy Stewart — breaks his leg on the job and suddenly finds himself wheelchair-bound for the next six weeks. To combat the torturous boredom born from sitting by his apartment window day by day, he begins to take pictures of what goes on around his apartment complex — families sitting down to dinner, lonely people closing their blinds to sit alone in the dark, and the comings and goings of his neighbors in the communal courtyard. One night, he notices there's a little piece of the courtyard lawn that doesn't seem quite right. He sees a fresh mound of grass. His mind races, and an idea sparks: Could it be his neighbor (Raymond Burr) has buried something there? Is this really happening or has he been stuck inside for too long? Until the chilling moment when Jimmy Stewart finds Raymond Burr staring at him through the barrel of his camera lens...
